PHASE 3 INSPECTION

WHAT IS A Phase 3 inspection?

A Phase 3 Inspection is the third and final phase of the construction process. This inspection happens after the home is complete but before the buyer closes on the home. This final inspection is conducted as a real estate transaction so it is regulated by the Texas Real Estate Commission. This inspection incorporates all the major systems in the home and is the most time consuming of the 3 phases.

WHAT DOES A-ACTION INSPECT?

The purpose of the final inspection is to ensure the major systems and components in the home are installed in accordance with common model building standards & that there are no observable major defects present prior to your purchasing the home from the builder. The final inspection is vital & highly recommended.

WHERE DO WE SERVE?

HOW MUCH DO WE CHARGE?
